March 7, 2006

Meeting held at West Langley Hall, 208th St. & 94th Ave., Langley B.C.

Meeting called to order by President Harold Swift at 7:30pm.

Harold welcomed everyone to our March Meeting.

81 Members and 20 guests were in attendance for a total of 101.

Committee Reports:

Treasurer - Keith Biddlecombe advised that due to membership renewals coming in, there was a larger than usual incoming cash flow (normal for this time of year).

Membership – Bill Alder was pleased to announce that 218 members had renewed their membership to date. Our membership roster was 285 at the end of last year so the renewals were rolling in very quickly. So remember, RENEWAL MEMBERSHIP APPLICATIONS are now due!!! Newsletter – Darlene Driedger announced that all is well with the production of the Headliner.

Web Master - Cam Hutchins reported that all was running well with the web site. He also mentioned that he had taken about 1000 pictures at the Seattle Roadster Show and that some of these shots were now up on his website. Cam also asked any and all members who have not got their ride pictures in our member gallery, they should email him some shots along with details so that he can get you into the gallery. President Harold also presented Cam with a certificate of appreciation for all of his efforts and the many hours it has taken for him to expand and up date the BCHRA Website. Thank You Cam for a big job well done!!

SVA – Harold Wellenbrink was pleased to report that he was back in action after some serious eye surgery. Harold thanked Ellie for the Get Well Card from the club. Harold also reported that the SVA's AGM would be held on March 25, 2006. Any and all BCHRA members were welcome to attend. It will be at the Coast Hotel in Langley. If you want to attend, please contact Harold at 604-574-5457. Harold also reported that ICBC was progressing with the changes to the 'Modified Collector Plate Program'. They had to calculate all of the rates for the additional years up to 1958 and publish the new rate manuals. They also had to provide additional pages for the training manuals for agents. Environmental groups as well as complaints from BC Air Care who were upset about lost revenue because of these changes were also hindering this process. It was felt that this could all be settled and put into effect by June or July. SVA has written a letter to ICBC to ask if they could advise of a clear date for completion, so that SVA could advise their members. There was a meeting scheduled for later in March. Once again we remind you that your financial support is needed to keep SVA going.

50th Anniversary Committee: Jim Greenwood Chairman was pleased to announce that

the committee had been moving forward with many efforts. He reminded us that the date for this event is JUNE 15, 16, and 17, 2007.
