Old car hobbyists in Ontario should be extra vigilant over the coming months. The Government of Ontario has announced plans to accelerate the timing of proposed review of the Drive-Clean program. Included in the recommendations for review from the acting Provincial Auditor was **elimination of the exemption of older vehicles. This recommendation appears to have the support of the Minister and of NDP-MPP Marilyn Churley.** It is obvious that none of these people have a clue about our hobby. They appear completely unaware of the limited miles that most of our cars are driven, and the resulting minimal impact on air quality. It also appears that they are unaware of the economic contribution our hobby makes every year, with attendance at car shows [ many of which support charities] increasing annually. This review, unless conducted with proper input from the old car hobby, could cripple our hobby and severely diminish the value of our cars!
