

What is the NAAACCC doing NOW?

Update 47, January 2006

- The NAAACCC is monitoring, Bill C32—Kyoto Accord, weekly through Hansard. **This generally takes 5 hours per week on average.**
- We are sitting on a variety of BC Provincial Committees to help shape proposed legislation (Air Care and the Department of Motor Vehicles) Our latest meeting took place in November 2005---**Note: BC and Ontario usually set the standard for emission testing in Canada.**
- We are working with SEMA and the National Motorists Association
- We are currently in discussions with the Federal Government to include collector motorcycles and collector cars to being exempt from emission testing Canada Wide. **In September of 2004** the NAAACCC submitted a reply to the **On-Road Vehicle and Engine Emission Regulations Updating Canada's Motorcycle Emission Standards To Align with New U.S. Rules Regulatory Development Division Transportation Systems Branch Environment Canada**
- In 2003, 2004, and 2005 we gave direction to every Province in Canada to form the necessary NAAACCC emission committees in their respective Provinces. In BC we are part of the BC Collector Car Council.
- **We have established a liability insurance program-- Canada wide.** (Please note we have been working on this for two years)—Pat Anderson

Agencies

has informed us that they now have the new program in place.

Lloyds of London are the insurers.

Note: As of January 1st 2006 the insurance program is now in place

- We are establishing a certification process and establishing a set of guidelines for Collector Vehicle Appraisers Canada-wide. **Don Cooper, AB, NAAACCC director**, is chairing this committee.
- **Bob Chambers, BC, NAAACCC director**, is chairing and expanding our safety vehicle guidelines committee for 2006
- We are setting up a National Data Base so that you can refer to it for help in your Province. **Steve Clements, NB, NAAACCC director**, is chairing this committee.

- **Derek Long , BC, NAAACCC director**, is chairing our corporate committee for sponsorships and wholesale discounts for you . We now have several major discount programs in place for NAAACCC members :
